Horse-drawn barge operating zone

You will be sharing this towpath with a large working heavy horse that pulls a passenger barge along this 3-mile stretch of canal up to 3 times a day from 1st April to 31st October



Towpath users safety information

Always give way to the horse Stand aside (on the hedge side of the towpath) and allow to pass.

Cyclists must dismount under all bridges in this zone and whenever passing the horse.

Never cause the horse to stop

This may cause danger for the barge.

Be vigilant Keep watch for the heavy horse before you walk under any bridge in this zone.

In the very unlikely event that you meet a horse out of control or running, stand well back for your safety.
